egotiating valiantly the odds weather, thousands spirited Kashmiris, motivated by the energising words of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, celebrated the 10th International Day of Yoga, on the rain drenched ground of Sheri-Kashmir International Convention Centre (SKICC) in Srinagar today. Applauding the spirit of Kashmiris, Prime Minister emphasised. also saw scores of girls covering themselves with the Yoga mat and they remained on the ground. This undaunted spirit of theirs and the love for Yoga is quite appreciable.'

Prime Minister expressed his gratitude for being present in Jammu & Kashmir, the land of Yog and Sadhna. He stated that the atmosphere, energy, and experience from Yoga could be felt in Jammu & Kashmir today. "Participation of 50-60 thousand people of Jammu and Kashmir with Yoga today on this occasion is a remarkable feat in itself." he said. The PM reminded that the theme for this year, "Yoga for Self and Society," highlights the significant contribution of Yoga in enhancing personal wellness and fostering social cohesion. He conveyed his best wishes on the International Day of Yoga to all citizens and those practising Yoga worldwide. PM took part in the Common Yoga Protocol (CYP) session, emphasising the significance of yoga in fostering physical, mental, and spiritual growth.

In commemoration of the 10th anniversary of International Yoga Day, Prime Minister highlighted that a remarkable 177 countries supported India's proposal in the UN. He also mentioned notable achievements in previous International Day of Yoga events, such as 35,000 individuals practising yoga on Kartavya Path (earlier known as Rajpath in Delhi) in 2015, and over 130 countries participating in the yoga event led by the Prime Minister at the UN Headquarters last year. GST taxpayers can now pay tax using UPI, debit cards, or credit cards

the Commercial Taxes Department, announced that this decision aims to enhance payment options and streamline the process for GST taxpayers. This new facility fol-



lows the integration of the State Treasury with the GST portal, extending a payment option previously available to VAT taxpayers to GST taxpavers as well.

Nahargarh Wildlife Sanctuary Committee Orders Demolition of Kanha Hotels Property for Illegal Land Occupation • Jaipur, June 26

he eco-sensitive zone (ESZ) monitoring committee of the Nahargarh Wildlife Sanctuary has instructed the Jaipur Development Authority (JDA) to demolish a property owned by Kanha Hotels and Spa Private Ltd, managed by Taj Amer, for illegally occupying land within the Nahargarh ESZ.

According to a news published in TOI, this directive follows the decision of the National Board for Wildlife (NBWL) standing committee, which refused to grant wildlife clearance to the hotel project during a meeting on February 22, 2024. Although the hotel building was constructed several years ago, it only began operations in 2023.

According to the minutes of the meeting dated June 24, "The Chairman discussed the compliance of the decision of the 78th meeting of the Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife held on 22.02.2024 with the members of the Monitoring Committee. It was unanimously decided that the compliance of the said decision



The villages affected by the Barmer-Jaisalmer Highway will be connected-ACS

he Barmer Lignite Mining Company, a state government joint venture, has allocated Rs 96 crore to connect villages affected by the Barmer-Jaisalmer Highway. This decision was made during a meeting chaired by Sandeep Verma, Additional Chief Secretary of the Public Works Department, held on Wednesday.

Sandeep Verma emphasized that residents of the Jalipa Kapurdi area have been adversely affected by inadequate connectivity due to the Barmer-Jaisalmer National Highway. He announced plans for constructing alternative and connecting roads to ensure better access to highways and improved road facilities for the local community.

Anandi, Secretary of Mines and Chairperson of BLMC, highlighted that during the 68th Board of Directors meeting in March, a decision was made to develop an action plan for connecting affected villages to a link road. The plan allocates Rs 27 crore for a new road and Rs 69 crore for connecting roads to

link villages such as Rohili, Lakhetali, and Chakdholak Jalipa via the National Highway, totaling Rs 96 crore.

further specified that the Public Works Department will oversee the road construction project, funded entirely by BLMCL. This initiative aims to significantly enhance road connectivity for approximately 5,000 villagers in the area. Anandi noted that BLMCL mines lignite from Kapurdi-Jalipa mines to fuel power generation, contributing to regional development efforts under corporate social responsibility.


